FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Financial assistance for which international students may apply is extremely limited. Federally funded loans, grants, and work-study programs dispersed through the Wallace State Financial Aid Office are limited to U.S. citizens and permanent residents. The majority of international students at Wallace State fund their educations through personal or family funds. Private loans are available, but require a co-signature by a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
